

ALKBOROUGH CEMETERY Regulations

1. The Cemetery will be filled one row at a time, starting in the northwest quarter along the wall. Each row will be filled before the next is started.
 2. Each plot is located by marks on the wall and path and will be filled in order.
 3. Individuals may reserve a plot only in the row currently in use.
 4. Families may reserve plots adjacent (in the same row) to an existing family grave.
 5. Headstones will have a maximum height of three feet and be set in concrete that is flush to the ground. Headstones will remain the responsibility of the family of the deceased: however, if found to be in a dangerous condition, the Parish Council reserves the right to take appropriate action.
 6. A stretch of the Cemetery, the width of one plot, and adjacent to a path will be set aside for the burial of cremation urns. Memorials will have a maximum height of 2 feet and a maximum width of 2 feet (which includes the base stone).
 7. It is expected that the Cemetery will be treated as a place of reverence, with visitors walking on paths and between graves. No dogs will be allowed.
 8. No glass vases will be permitted.
 9. No flowers, shrubs or trees may be planted within the Cemetery.
 10. The Parish Council reserves the right to remove, without notice, anything considered dangerous.
